Mandatory Modules in the first and second semester

(per module: 2 seminars, 1 research paper (15-25 pages), 10 credits - total of 40 credits):

- International Security;
- Strategy;
- Research Methods and Tools;
- Geostrategy, Technology and Security.



4 Mandatory Modules 3 Elective Modules Module at a

Elective Modules starting in the first semester (select 3 out of 5 modules, 10 credits per module - total of **30** credits), choose from the following:

- International Law (2 lectures, 1 seminar + 1 sxam + 1 termpaper);
- Global Power Shifts and International Order (2 seminars + 1 termpaper);
- German Foreign and Security Policy (2 seminars + 1 termpaper);
- Foreign Policy & International Relations (1 plenary, 1 seminar, 1 tutorial + 1 exam);
- Intelligence and National Security (1 lecture, 1 seminar + 1 exam) starting in the summer term 2025.

Internship (recommended in the third or fourth semester, MSIS office can provide support with finding an internship position):

- Mandatory for completion of the programme;
- Recommended 3 months, minimum duration of 6 weeks, working full-time or its equivalent in a role closely related to the program and its content;
- Mandatory to hand in proof of completion of the internship.

Master Thesis:

- Registration for thesis possible after obtaining 60 credits and attending a Colloquim to work on your thesis idea;



Your Uni-ID

Activation

After receiving your Uni-ID with your student card, the first thing you have to do is activate it online. When activating your Uni-ID, we recommend that you enter a private mail address so that you can reset your password online at any time.

Password & Request for Investigation


The password must not be passed on to third parties under any circumstances, should always be unique and comply with the rules for a secure password.

For security reasons, change your password regularly. If you have forgotten your password, you can recover it if you have a private mail address on file. If you have forgotten your Uni-ID or have not deposited your private mail address, you must submit an investigation request.

Registration via BASIS: General Information


- Every lecture or seminar is connected to a module and can only be completed in that module, they cannot be combined;
- Every module includes both assignments (Studienleistungen) that need to be completed in order to be admitted to the examination
 - Examples: presentation, essay, exercises;
- Every module includes a certain number of examinations that need to be passed in order to complete the module
 - Examples: termpaper, exam, oral exam.

• Please keep in mind that you can only register for a final module examination when all assignments in a module has been completed!






Other Functions of BASIS


